

Frazier Lake Airpark (1C9) is a unique real world privately owned airport located near Hollister California. It is open to the public and on the first Saturday of each month the Airpark has an open house when it puts its antique and homebuilt aircraft on display to the public.

It's uniqueness is in the fact that it not only has a turf runway but a parallel water runway.

This project was a joint effort between Tom Gibson and Noel Sivertson with Tom providing the VTP features for the water runway. The scenery is semi detailed with a few objects indicative of a small privately owned airport and the addition of the T-Hangars on the southeast corner of the airfield as shown in photographs of the airpark..

INSTALLATION:

In addition to the three basic RWY12 object libraries you will need the following from flightsim.com:

RWY12-12.zip
ga-hange.zip

SCENERY

Place the Frazier Lake scenery folder in your FS9/addon scenery/scenery folder. You need to add it to the Scenery Library as a separate layer.

Place downloaded object libraries in your FS9/addon scenery/static objects library/scenery folder and any textures in the FS9/addon scenery/standard objects library/texture folder. If you did not have such a layer before, add it to the Scenery Library too.

AI AIRCRAFT

Download AI Aircraft

If you have already installed California Classics GA traffic files you already have the Cessna 170 and Tripacer. If you have already installed the California Seaplane Bases scenery you will not need to download the Luscombe. Otherwise:

Piper Tripacer

Download File - pa24_04.zip - n6839d.zip (texture)

Download Location - flightsim.com

Modifications required - Use the default FS9 Piper PA-28 air file. Edit the aircraft.cfg file as

follows:

Modifications required:

After installing it as directed copy the C170FLT.air file from the Cessna 170 to the Luscombe folder. Then rename the aircraft.cfg file to aircraft.bak and copy the modified aircraft.cfg file in the Luscombe New CFG File folder to the Luscombe folder.

If you want to fly the Luscombe (and Bill Lyons' Luscombe is a delight to fly) then change the name of the ai Luscombe file and install the aircraft again. The Luscombe was one of the few aircraft of it's type that had a stick instead of a yoke.

TRAFFIC

The traffic text files have been provided for those who wish to add or alter flights.

Traffic for this scenery consists of one Luscombe 8A seaplane making 30 minute local flights every hour, a Cessna 170 making touch and goes, and a Piper TriPacer making a round trip to Hillview-Reid airport near San Jose every 2 hours.

Frazier Lake is a unique addition to the San Francisco Bay Area GA flying community. We hope it will add interest for those California Classics general aviation aviators who fly around that area.
